ENTRANCE - Enter the hotel property from Mansfield Avenue via Doubletree Drive. (see enclosed brochure)

PARKING – Some parking is available in the lower lot and ample parking is available in the upper lot.

INDIVIDUAL INDUCTEE REGISTRATION – Please plan your arrival no later than 3:45PM. Reservation will be in the Duquesne Room. (see enclosed map)

INDUCTEE RECEPTION – A reception for inductees and their family will be held in the Duquesne Room.

INDUCTEE INTRODUCTIONS – At 5:40 PM, inductees are to proceed to the main ballroom. Mr. Shovlin will introduce each inductee (in alphabetical order). Each inductee then will proceed to the head table and remain standing until all inductees have been introduced.

INDUCTION CEREMONY –After dinner, each inductee will be called to the podium and be presented a Hall of Fame Plaque and Medal by their committee representative. The team inductees will be represented by their coach, who in turn will recognize the team members present and call them to come forward to receive their medal. All team members are to remain standing up front until all have received their award.
