Group Participation Requirements & Guidelines

Group Per Member Fee

100% Organization (Tier 2) (Minimum 50+) \$25

100% Organization (Tier 3) (Minimum 800+) \$17

Small Group (1-50+ members) \$35

100% Organization (Tier 2 & 3) – State organization that is sport specific or any local organization:

- 100% of organizational members must be NFHS Officials Association members
- Minimum number of organizational members must be met on initial submission
- All officials **must have** a unique ID# (**NO SSN**) assigned to them that never changes and not reused for other officials. (**Note: If not submitted electronically with unique ID#, membership fee is \$35 per member.**)
- All submissions of membership data must be electronic (disc or e-mail, contact NFHS for more information)
- Membership begins upon receipt of appropriate fees and data
- Membership period is one year from the date payment is received by the NFHS
- One (1) contact person must be provided to the NFHS that is responsible for submission information, billing, correspondence, etc.
- Email addresses **required** to receive access to online benefits on the NFHS Officials Central Hub
- Eligible for online testing through the NFHS National Test platform
- Free – NFHS Officiating Course “Interscholastic Officiating”
- Membership cards sent to individual members via first class mail

Special Group – State or local organization with less than 50 members, or any organization not meeting requirements for Tier 2 or 3 above:

- Sent to NFHS by individuals or special groups less than 50
- One (1) contact person must be provided to the NFHS that is responsible for group information, billing, correspondence, etc.
- Data submitted through paper application (contact NFHS for application)
- Roster Renewal notice sent to contact person listing all officials expiring for your group
- Membership period is one year from the date appropriate payment and data is received by the NFHS or anniversary date, whichever is greater
- Email addresses required to receive access to our new NFHS Officials Central Hub
- Membership cards sent to individual members via first class mail
- Free – NFHS Officiating Course “Interscholastic Officiating”
